Description of Service	Legal Fee <sup>1</sup>	Anticipated Costs
Applying for permanent residence based on a marriage to a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, including changing one's current status to that of a permanent resident	\$1,295	Government filing fees for the I-130 and I-485
Applying for work authorization for a permanent resident	\$375	Government filing fees for the I-765
Applying for advance travel parole (limited permission to travel internationally during permanent residence process)	\$395	Government filing fees for the I-131
Changing or adjusting your current status to that of a permanent resident (for those people who already have an approved permanent residence petition)	\$975	Government fees for the I-485
Applying for U.S. Citizenship (naturalization)	\$800	Government fees for the N-400
Applying for a fiancée visa to permit marriage in the United States	\$995	Government fees for the I-129F
Applying to bring your spouse to the United States, if you are a U.S. citizen	\$795	Government filing fees for the I-129F
Removal of conditions for Permanent Residence	\$595	Government filing fees

Permanent Residence for foreign worker who has a Master's Degree or higher	\$4,850	Government filing fees; courier fees of approximately \$50; case activation fee of \$30
Request Labor Certification from the Department of Labor for a particular position	\$2,950	Case activation of \$30
Apply for permanent residence based on an approved Labor Certification	\$1,900	Government filing fees; courier fees of approximately \$50; case activation fee of \$30
